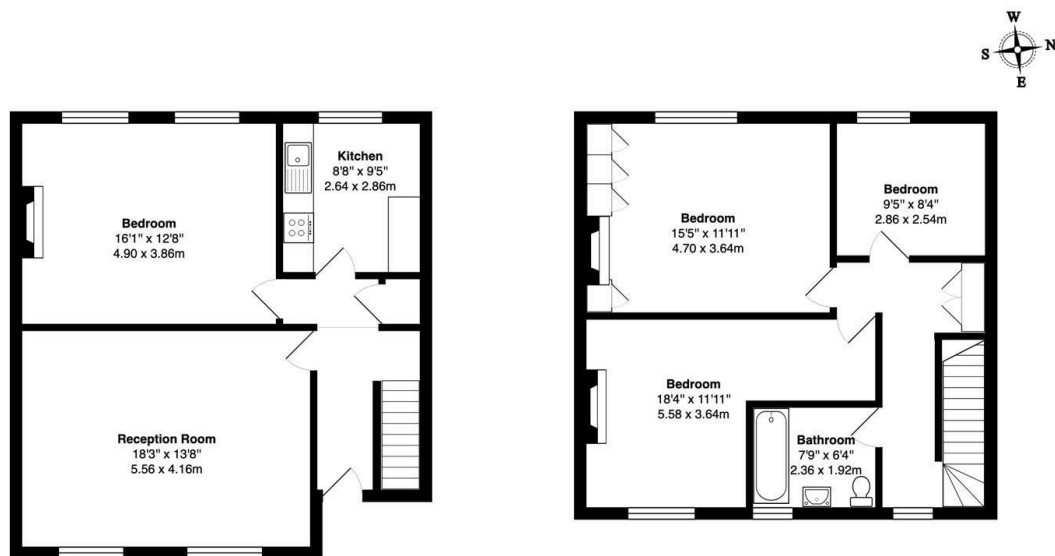
The property is ideally located and overlooks the stunning gardens of Compton Terrace whilst being only moments from the hustle and bustle of Upper Street.

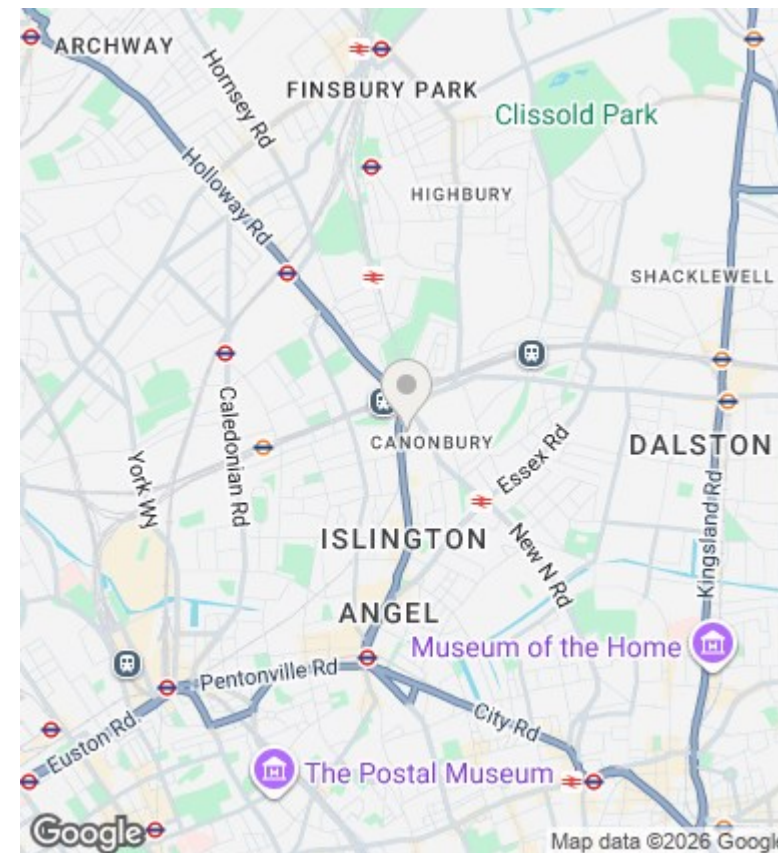
