

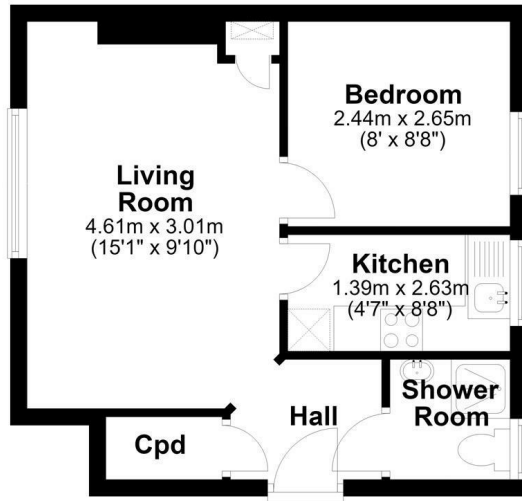

A ground floor one-bedroom flat, comprising 330 sq ft, quietly tucked away from the High Street and benefiting from off-street parking and no onward chain.

Accessed via secure entry, the entrance leads directly to the bathroom, which is fitted with a shower unit, WC and basin. There is also a useful storage cupboard.

The living space is well proportioned and enjoys a window overlooking the communal gardens. Off the living area is the kitchen, fitted with a range of high and low level cupboards, an integrated gas hob and oven, kitchen sink and washing machine connection. The bedroom is a reasonable size and also benefits from a window, allowing for natural light.

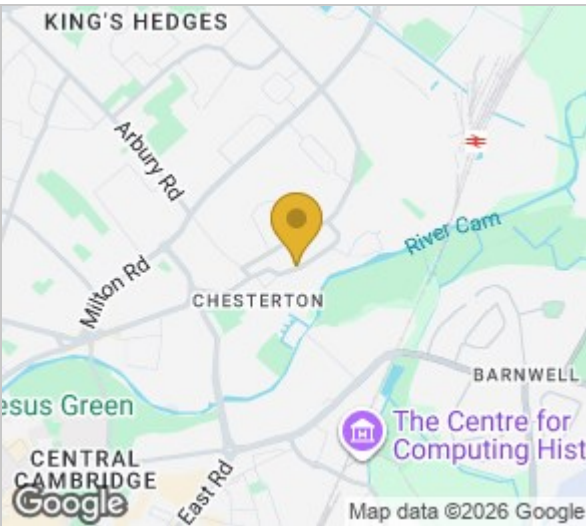
